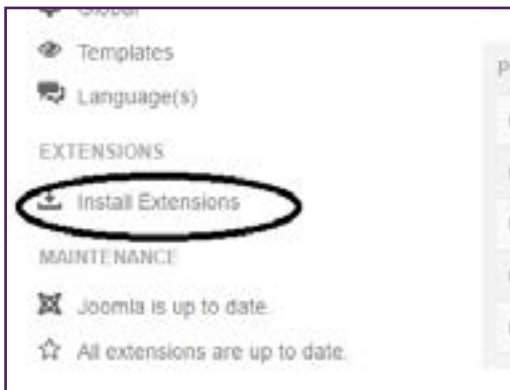




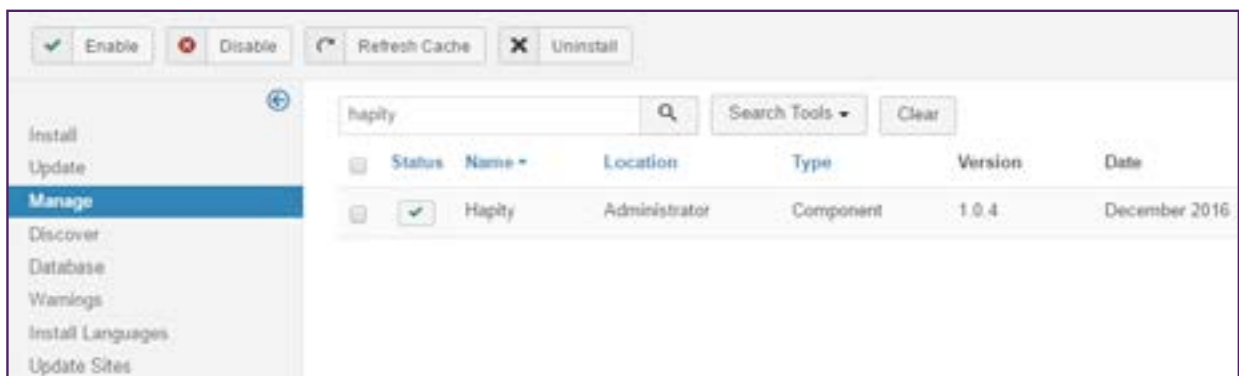
## HAPITY FOR JOOMLA

Setup is simple and only needs to be done the first time.  
More detailed instructions and video demonstrations are [here](#).

- 1 Go to <https://www.hapity.com>  
Login or register with the buttons on top right hand corner.  
(Registering requires a name, email address and password)
- 2 Choose **Settings** on top right hand corner.  
Make a note of the plugin ID.
- 3 Download Hapity Joomla module from [here](#)  
Unzip module and place into **[Joomla root]/components/** folder  
Login to your Joomla admin site. /administrator
- 4 Click on **Install Extensions** (/administrator/index.php?option=com\_installer)

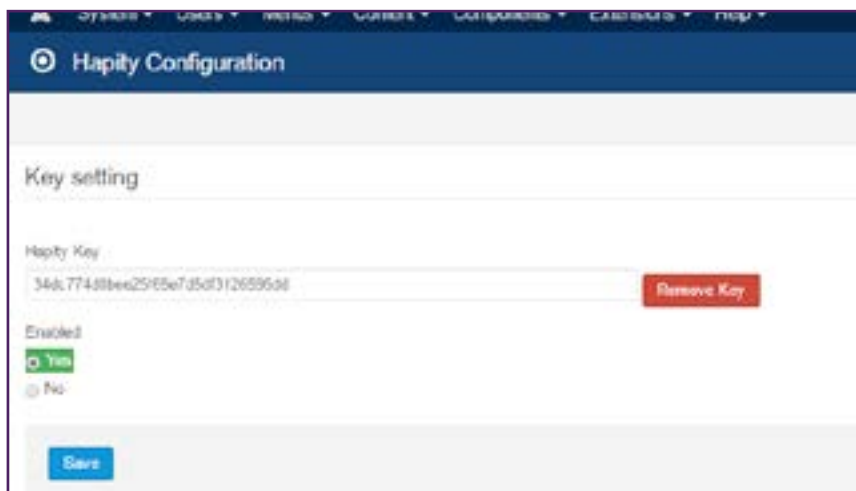


- 5 Then click on **manage** find Hapity in list of modules and enable it.



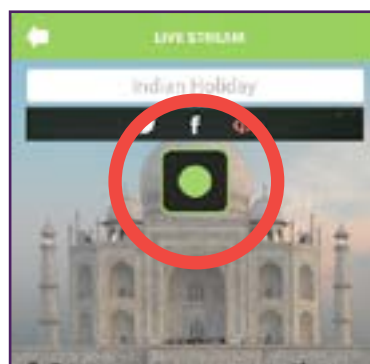
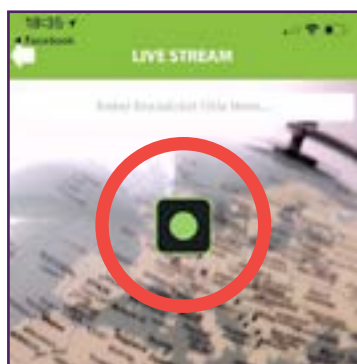
From Components menu select **Hapity**

- 6 On Configurations page (/administrator/index.php?option=com\_hapity) Paste Hapity key from step 1 (<http://www.hapity.com/main/settings>) into **Hapity Key** and click **Save**.



## To Broadcast

If your PC has a camera you can instantly broadcast by going to Hapity and pressing the start button. Alternatively you can download Hapity from the Android Playstore or Apple App store. Use your login from Step 1. Click the Live Stream button within the app. Enter a name for the broadcast (this is optional) and press the start button.



## Tips

You can share the broadcast on Facebook and Twitter before or after by selecting the appropriate icons. The first time you will be asked to login to your Facebook or Twitter account. You can also share the video on email, SMS, whatsapp and many other platforms. A video file of all the broadcasts will be saved to your phone as well which can be found in your **Gallery** for android and **Photos** for iPhone.

You own the content you livestream.

No need to update your website hardware or worry about additional web data charges as all of the broadcasting is handled in the background by Hapity servers.
